We will be composing and discussing sentences orally, including dialogue, progressively building a varied and rich vocabulary and an increasing range of sentence structures.

We will write informal letters, instructions, biographies, recounts, character profiles, stories and poetry using stories by Roald Dahl as a stimulus.

In French we will learn to use simple greetings, name colours and count to 20.

As Scientists we will learn about:

- Solids and liquids
- Food Chains and Nutrition

We will work scientifically by observing, sorting and classifying.

We will also investigate how food can be altered by making scrumdiddlyumptious foods such as edible slime, green pancakes, and exploding chocolate drops!
