Document what happens, but DON'T open the container!</p>	<p>Remembrance Day:</p> <p>On Thursday it is Remembrance Day. A very important date in the UK calendar. What can you find out about Remembrance day? Make notes on what you find out, use the Internet to help you!</p>	<p>Make a papier-mâché model rat:</p> <p>Make a model rat out of papier-mâché. Paint it to make it look realistic. Take a picture of your rat in different places... but try not to scare anyone!</p>	<p>War of the Roses:</p> <p>Research the War of the Roses. Make notes on key events that have happened. Have a go at drawing the symbol for the War of the Roses!</p>	<p>Fun during Medieval times!</p> <p>Produce a poster showing all the different ways that people had fun in Medieval England.
