Miss Watkins has offered to make one of her lovely cakes, which will be raffled at the Harvest. Tickets will be 50p each and will be available to purchase next week.


The children have been enthusiastically practising their parts for the Harvest. We look forward to seeing you all on Thursday afternoon at 2.30 in the hall.
