## Partial Closure Arrangements

As you may know, Scotland will be going into a full lockdown until at least the end of January 2021.

I don't wish to alarm people, but it seems extremely likely that the Prime Minister will announce some tougher restrictions for us in England in the very near future.

If it is the case that we will need to partially close the school for a period of time, then I will be posting details of our remote learning arrangements shortly. The arrangements will mirror the arrangements during the first lockdown. This approach was using work set via email, Google Classroom, and Tapestry. We will also be sending home (or arranging collection depending on the notice we are given) different workbooks and materials, for those of you who need a paper based approach with your child.

### Rainbow School

During the first lockdown we were open for children of key Workers and other identified children. I fully anticipate that this will be the case if we needed to close again.

If you are one of these workers, we will need to gather information quickly which will allow us to book a place for your child/children and make the necessary arrangements. It is likely that this schooling will take place, as before, at Blakeney.

Pillowell key worker children will be required to go to Blakeney, as before. This is necessary to staff the setting safely.

These arrangements are provisional, and may need to change as the situation develops.
