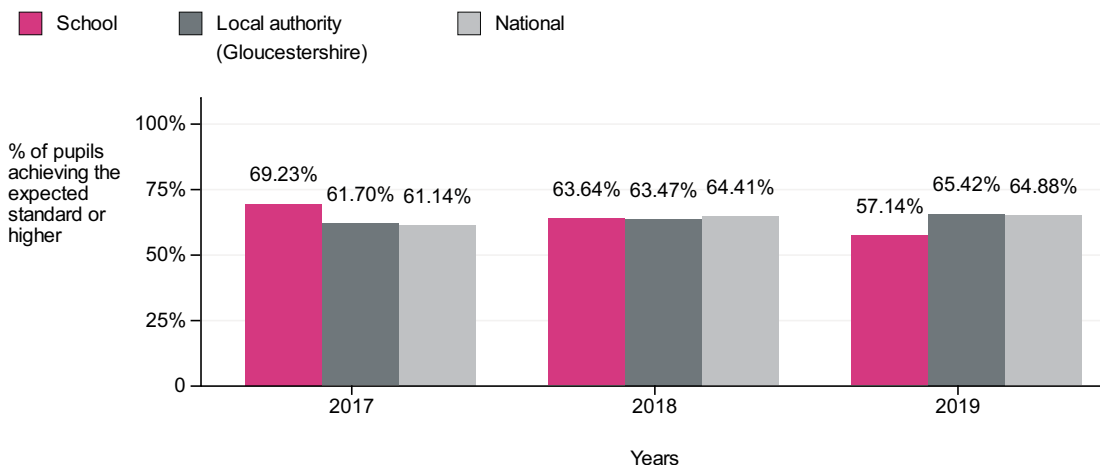

Number of pupils in 2019 = 14

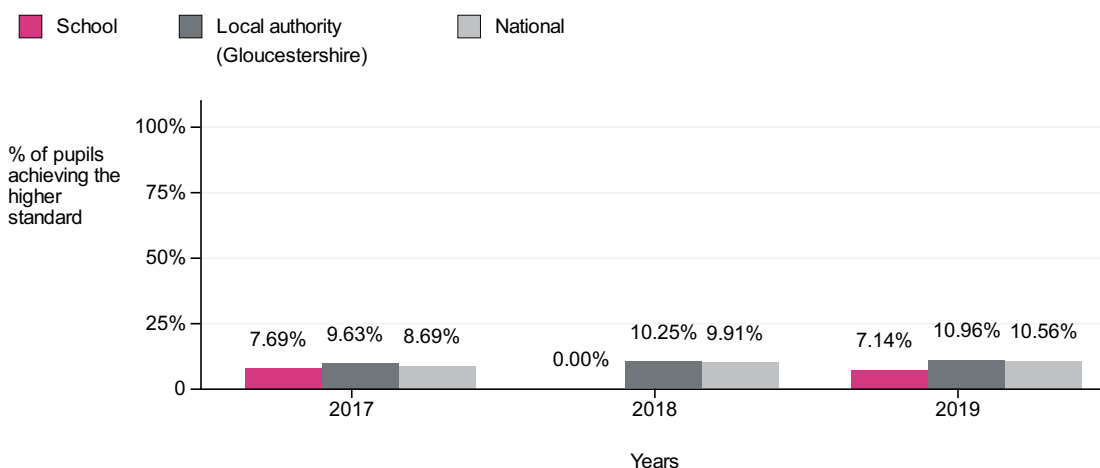


## Percentage of pupils achieving the higher standard

Number of pupils in 2019 = 14



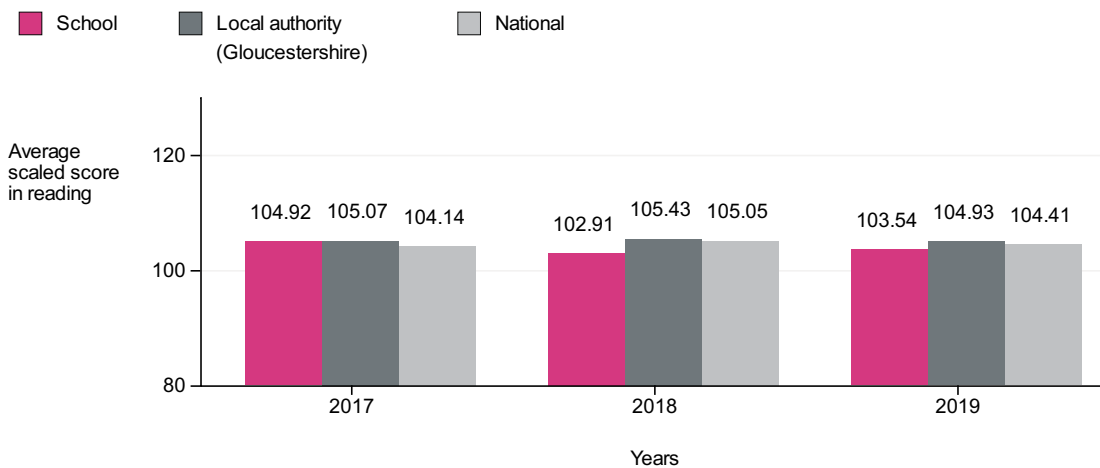
